

Rotary District Conference and Carnival
Frequently asked questions:

- Where: Zane State/Ohio University - Zanesville, OH
- When: Saturday, May 19, 2018
- Time: 1:00PM to 4:00PM.
- Who: Rotary District 6690 Interact, Youth Exchange, Rotaract & RYLA participants are eligible to submit their Carnival Game idea(s) to Rotary District 6690.

1---How will we know if our idea has been approved?

All submitted game ideas will be reviewed and approved based on a first come, first served basis. Notification will sent via email to youth teams in early February. Students are therefore asked to await the notification & approval of their game idea BEFORE purchasing or soliciting materials, supplies needed for building their game.

2---What is the deadline to submit carnival game ideas?

Application deadline: Friday, January 19, 2018

3---What type of games are needed?

Carnival games only are requested.

4---How many game ideas may each Youth team submit?

We are requesting that teams submit no more than TWO Carnival game ideas.

4a---What comprises a youth team?

A team is a group of 2 - 5 youth. Teams may be a group of Interact/Rotaract/RYE/RYLA participants or any combination of the above.

5---Who creates and runs the Carnival game?

Games must be planned, built & run entirely by youth during the conference/carnival.

6---Game supplies?

Youth are encouraged to be creative and to use materials/supplies/decorations from home. Solicited or donated supplies from area businesses & their local Rotary Club are okay to use.

7---Where will the Carnival take place?

Carnival will be held outdoors on a grassy area (weather permitting) in the quad space on the North side of campus. Indoor space is available in the event of inclement weather.

8---Will electricity or a hose/water available?

Electricity and hose/water are not readily available. If a small amount of water is needed it may be possible to use a bathroom sink and bucket to transport water to the area.

9---Is adult supervision required for Youth participation?

Teams are encouraged to have an adult advisor, Rotarian or chaperone present during the Carnival.

10---Length of Carnival?

*Youth teams are encouraged to arrive by 12:30PM to set up their game/display.
Tear down will start at 4:00PM*

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11---Who will be participating in the Carnival games?

Rotarians and their families including some young children will be participating in the Carnival games.

12---How will this work?

Rotarians may purchase tickets to use to play the games. Players that win at any given game will be given a golden ticket which they may then exchange for a prize at the prize table. The more golden tickets they have the greater the prize. Youth Teams with the highest number of players/tickets will be recognized & receive a prize.

13---How will the money raised from the Carnival be used?

Money Raised will be donated to Polio Plus.
